


Ski-doo Carbon Fiber Rear Bumper (183-120, 183-122) 2008-17 Ski-doo

Installation Instructions

- 1. Insert the aluminum plug into the carbon tube. Be sure that the holes will line-up as removal of the aluminum plug may be hard after inserted. Insert the 10-24 x 1/4 screws through the carbon tube and into the plug and tighten.
- 2. Unbolt the stock bumper from the inside of the tunnel. Keep the stock torx bolts and reuse them for the installation.
- 3. Lightly bolt the rails onto the tunnel using the stock torx button head bolts and the supplied M8x 1.25 nuts to install the new SPI rails.
- 4. Next, bolt the carbon fiber bumper in-between the rails, there will be a small gap on some of the installs as shown in picture #4. On certain year, make, and models the rear snow flap will hit the rails. This is normal, and will have no issues.
